

# Syracuse Invitational

## February 3&4, 2006

### **General Information**

The Syracuse Invitational will take place on Friday & Saturday, February 3&4, 2006 at Syracuse University's Manley Field House. The women's pentathlon and first day events of men's heptathlon will all be on Friday, while the second day of the men's heptathlon and the main open meet will finish up on Saturday. The facility consists of a 6-lane 200-meter flat track considered to be extremely fast. The straightaway has 8 lanes. The surface is synthetic -- 1/4" spikes are allowed.

### **Eligibility**

Only invited schools and teams can participate. Open athletes maybe allowed in on an availability basis. (check through Dave Hegland) The meet will be conducted according to NCAA Track and Field Rules.

### **Entries**

Entries should be available in the next few days. You can make them online through C.F.P.I Timing. [www.cfpitiming.com](http://www.cfpitiming.com)

### **Entry Fee**

\$100.00 (US) per team, (\$200.00 for men and women); \$25.00 per athlete if less than 10 entries. Make check payable to Syracuse University. Please bring entry fee to the meet.

### **Entry Limitations**

5 athletes for running events, 4 for field events. 2 teams allowed per relay.

### **Weight Throw**

Implement weigh-in for the men's weight will be from 9:00 am-9:45 am. Women's implement weigh-in is to be determined. Check for time at packet pickup.

### **Packet Pickup**

Starting Saturday, February 4th, at 10:00 am in Manley Field House Arena.

### **Sports Medicine**

Athletic trainers will be available throughout the meet. Feel free to bring your trainer.

### **Showers**

Limited shower facilities and dressing areas will be provided for your team.

### **Unattached Athletes**
