



CrossRoads League Cross Country Championships 2012 Race Information

1. Women's race will begin at 11:30 a.m., Men's race will be at 12:30.
2. Entries need to be made through DirectAthletics no later than October 25. Entries after October 25 will be charged a \$25.00 late fee payable at the post season qualifier meet. No late entries will be accepted after October 26. (This is from the NAIA coaches manual- online entries)
3. The race is being held at IWU Cross Country Course at the athletic fields.
4. Buses can drop athletes off at the course but will need to park at the end of the drive at the Troyer Fieldhouse parking lot. Restrooms are available at concession stand area and Troyer Fieldhouse.
5. The course will be marked with white lines. There will be mile and kilometers marked on the ground.
6. The course is mostly grass. There are two paved crossovers that we will cross two or three times each.
7. Athletes should report to the starting line 10 min. prior to the start of their race for.
 - a. National Anthem will be 25 minutes prior to the women's race.
 - b. There is no need for final instructions. Make sure your athletes know the course.
 - c. There will be a guideline. If that guideline goes around a tree, flag, stake or other fixed structure regardless of it's purpose, athletes are required to go around the same. Athletes are also required to stay on the mowed course. There is no specific NCAA rule on distance from the guideline. Course marshalls will report any infraction to the starter who will make a determination. Appeals may be made to the appeals committee.
8. Awards will follow 30 min. after the conclusion of the men's race at the either Troyer Fieldhouse (increment weather) or at the finish line.
9. We are using chip timing and instructions will be given at the meet as to the type of chips we will be using. We will record numbers at the finish as well as video tape the finish as back up.
